On day 7 explore Waienga Bay on the North side of the the island at the foot of the majestic Ile Api volcano, an area known to produce the best ikats of Lembata. Go ashore to visit one of the most culturally traditional villages on the island. In the evening beach BBQ.

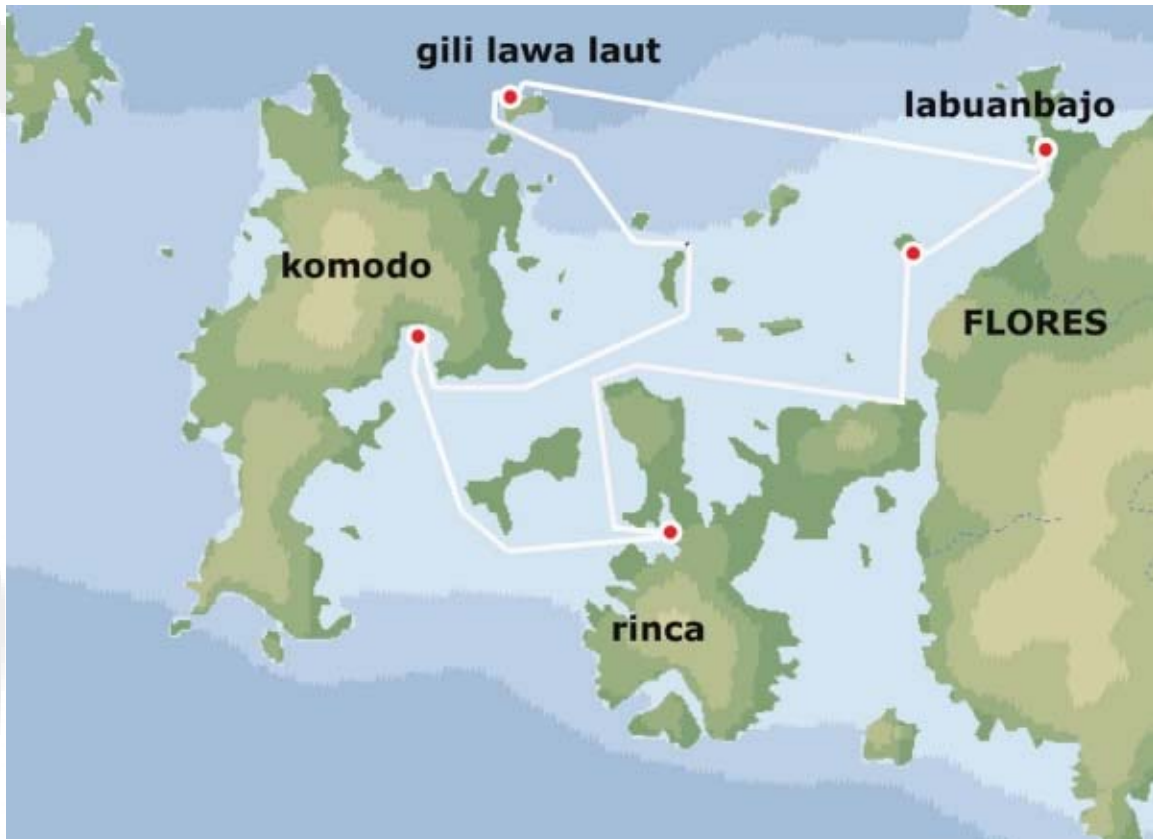

After a short sail along the Northern Coast you also pay a visit to Rinca village. Finally move to Kelor Island where in the evening the crew will prepare a romantic beach barbecue under the stars.

On day five sail back to Flores and after a morning excursion to witness a spectacular ancient whip fight dance by the local Manggarai people then take you to the Labuan Baju airport for your return flight to Bali.

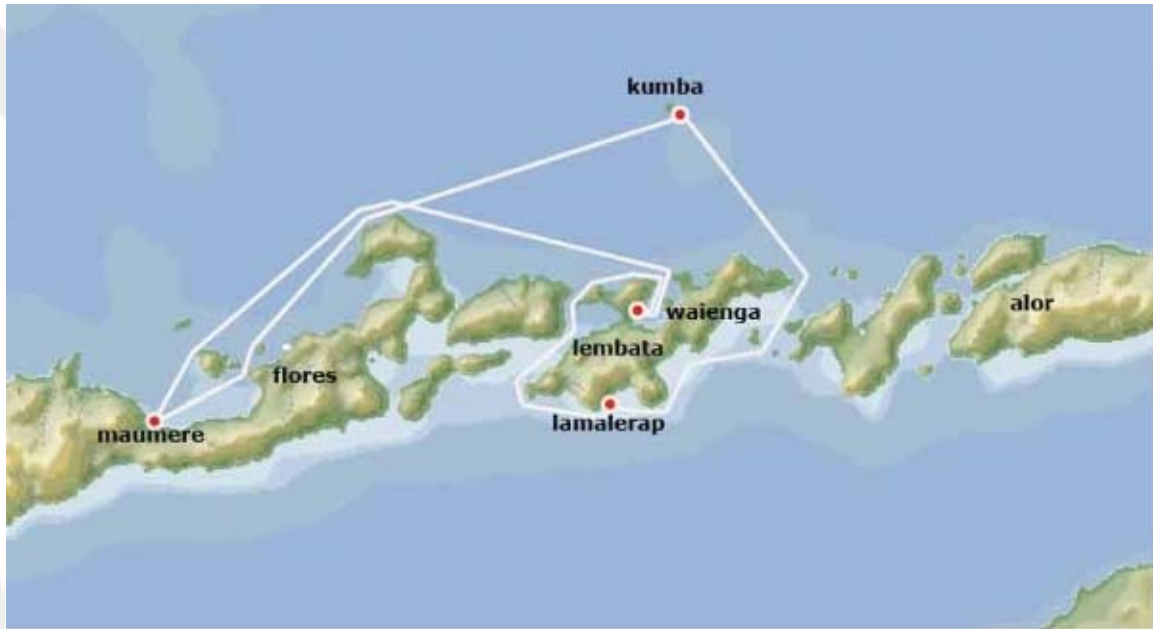
